New EPA Required Lead Renovation, Repair & Painting Certification Class for Contractors

Effective October 1, 2010, the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) "**Lead: Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule**" (RRP) requires any Contractor to have a Lead Renovator's Certification who works on a house or a child occupied facility (school, day care facility, etc.) built before 1978 and disturbs 6 sq. ft. or more of lead-based painted surface. Contractors must complete, or be registered for, the Lead Renovation, Repair & Painting Certification class by September 30, 2010 to be in compliance with EPA regulations.

View the EPA's website (www.epa.gov/lead/pubs/sbcomplianceguide.pdf) and read the "**Small Entity Compliance Guide to Renovate Right.**" This gives you an overview of the rule and how it applies to you as a contractor.

Certification class is a "hands-on" skills course with mandatory proficiency assessments. Fees include all class materials, supplies, exam, certificate of completion and registration with the EPA.
